“ I worked for Terrill Corley for over 37 years. He was a man of incredible dignity, integrity, honor, intelligence, determination and compassion for humanity and for the law. He served as the President of the Oklahoma Trial Lawyers Association, he took on large corporations when others failed, he genuinely cared about his clients and the achievement of justice. He has held the Oklahoma State record for the largest verdict in a product liability action for over three decades.

Terrill grew up on a farm in Eufaula, Oklahoma. He was the youngest of five sons and the last surviving member of his family of origin. He was the epitome of a self-made man. He loved his family and worked very, very hard to provide them a life that he could have only dreamed of in his youth. He gave his clients every single ounce of his ability as he pursued just-compensation on their behalf. He continued to press forward in a cases when others fell to the wayside.

I went to work for Terrill when I was 24 years old. I learned more from that man than from any other person or resource in my life. By example, he demonstrated what was possible for a human being that deployed self-discipline, a boatload of determination and a tremendous amount of "heart."
