



## Earlene Sue Duncan

October 26, 1936 - January 28, 2022

Earlene Sue (Glass) Duncan was born at home in Gerty, Oklahoma on October 26, 1936 – the third and last child to Earl Cromwell Glass and Arloene ‘Betty’ (Carroll) Glass. Sue and her family moved between Southern California and Oklahoma during her youth. She married Richard Earl Johnson in Los Angeles, California on September 16, 1955, at the age of 18.
