Earlene Marie Lewis, 76, of Dewey, Oklahoma, died Tuesday, December 15, 2020.

Earlene was born January 26, 1944, Wann, Oklahoma, to parents William Earl and Ada Marie (Johnson) Lewis. She graduated from Dewey High School in 1962 and also received her Associates degree from Coffeyville Community College.

She co-owned Lewis Drug Sundries in Copan, where she was known for making the best cheeseburgers around. She then worked for HC Price and Central States before starting her approximately 40 year career at Wal-Mart. Earlene loved to paint, go to the casino and take “drives”. She was a lifetime member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary.

She was preceded in death by her parents and older brother George Benton Lewis.

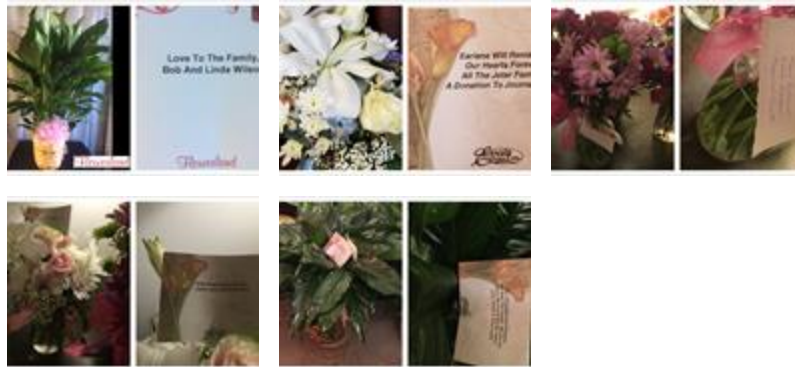
