Edgar Bruce Ramsay was born on November 17, 1946 at Hobbs, New Mexico the son of James Woody and Elizabeth (English) Ramsay. He joined the US Navy in November of 1963 and transferred to the Marine Corp in 1965. He went to Chulai, Viet Nam. He was released from active duty in November of 1967 and honorably discharged in December of 1969. He had worked as a Construction Superintendent and Construction Manager on numerous Petro-Chemical, Power Plants, Pipelines and Compressor Stations worldwide. He retired in 1995 due to a spinal injury. He came to Barnsdall in 1993 and moved there and made it his home in 1995. He married Diana Marie Ward on October 11, 2013.

His is survived by his wife Diana Marie Ramsay of the home, four daughters, Elizabeth Ramsay Asire of Clute, Texas, Shelly Covington of Duncan, Oklahoma, Tina Gallaway of Moore, Oklahoma and Melissa Thomason of Ardmore, Oklahoma and two granddaughters and numerous grand and great

“*Edgar Bruce Ramsay, was born Nov. 17, 1946, in Hobbs, New Mexico, and died May 14, 2014, in Bartlesville, Oklahoma. He was predeceased by his parents, Hazle Elizabeth English and James Woodrow (Woody) Ramsay, his older brother James Carl Ramsay, and his younger sister, LaQuita Susan Teakell.*

Bruce enlisted in the United States Navy in 1963, during his senior year of high school, and graduated from the San Diego Naval Training Center on January 20, 1964. He completed his high school equivalency in the Navy, was trained as corpsman and served in Vietnam. He was transferred to the US Marine Corps and received medic training. He served 3 years 11 months and 9 days, and a two-year reserve period, and was an E4 when discharged.

After his discharge, he trained as a welder and went on to attend college in Oklahoma and became a Civil Engineer and worked building petrochemical plants for some years.

He was married 6 times, twice to Diana Marie Ward, of Oklahoma City, who survives him, two daughters, Barbara (Bobby) Jo Ramsay and Elizabeth Mancha Asire, of Clute, Texas, five grandchildren, Cassandra (Casey) Fulsom, Megan Asire, Evan James Funderburk, Patric Asire and Brooke Asire, of Clute, Texas, step-granddaughter, Alyssa Bielman and husband Derek, stepdaughters, Shelly Covington of Duncan, Oklahoma, Tina Gallaway of Moore, Oklahoma and Melissa Thomason of Ardmore, Oklahoma, and great-grandchildren, Kathryn Fulsom, Halie Asire, Addison Bielman and Cameron Bielman of Clute, Texas and several step--grandchildren.
