



Elmer E Brannon

September 21, 1930 - November 26, 2023

Elmer Earl Brannon went to his heavenly reward on Sunday morning, November 26th. Originally born in Aberdeen, SD, Elmer had resided in Bartlesville for the last 24 years. Elmer graduated with a Bachelor of Religion degree from Marion College in Marion, IN and went on to serve as a pastor in the Wesleyan Church. He pastored churches in Lawrence Creek (KS), Belleville (KS), Kansas City (KS), Denver (CO), and finally Colorado Springs (CO), where he also volunteered as a police chaplain for 23 years. He eventually became District Superintendent for the Colorado District of the Wesleyan Church and served 16 years on the Oklahoma Wesleyan University Board of Trustees. He also tuned pianos for over 60 years until the age of 90. After retirement from ministry, Elmer moved to Bartlesville where he worked as OKWU's President's Ambassador for Church Relations. He was a member of the First Wesleyan Church in Bartlesville.

Elmer is preceded in death by his parents, Walter and Erma Brannon, his three brothers and sister-in-laws, Ronald and Rosalee Brannon, Walter and Virginia Brannon, and Gerald Brannon as well as his brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Yorton and Thelma Clark. He is survived by his wife of 72 years, Velma, three daughters and sons-in-law: Marcia and Tim Mitchell (Ottawa, KS), Connie and Rick Cook (Dewey, OK) and Janell and Tim Westveer (Bartlesville, OK), seven grandchildren, and nine great grandchildren.

The funeral service will be Saturday afternoon, Dec. 2 at 1:30pm at First Wesleyan Church in Bartlesville.
