Eugene "Gene" Towers of Bartlesville transitioned peacefully at 7:18 PM on Wednesday, February 19, at Adams Parc Rehabilitation Facility. A Reflection of Life Service will be held from 6 to 8 PM on Thursday, at Stumpff Funeral Home.

A Celebration of Life Service will be held at 11 AM on Friday at Spirit Church, 2121 Madison Blvd., with Pastor Darryl Wootton officiating and Rev. Victor Paul, as eulogist. Interment will be in the Sanders Cemetery in Nowata County, directed by Stumpff Funeral Home and Crematory.
