Evelyn Kay Snodgrass, 71, of Bartlesville, died at 11:08 A.M. Saturday, September 22, 2012 at the Jane Phillips Medical Center.

Funeral services will be held at 10 A.M. Tuesday, September 25, 2012 at the Labadie Heights Baptist Church with Pastor Mike McNair and Johnathan Long officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

She grew up in Bartlesville and attended Labadie Heights Elementary School, Central Junior High and College High School where she graduated in 1959. She was married to Burnie Joe Snodgrass on March 10, 1961 at the Church of the Bretheran in Bartlesville.

They made their home in the Bartlesville area and Mr. Snodgrass preceded her in death on February 1, 2009. She was the family historian and photographer and was active with her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. She was a member of the Labadie Heights Baptist Church and the Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary.
