Florene Elizabeth (Stafford) Britt, 99, of Bartlesville, Oklahoma and formerly of Dimmitt, Texas, died at 2:38 P.M. on Friday, June 26, 2015 at the Jane Phillips Medical Center in Bartlesville.

Funeral services for Mrs. Britt will be held at 1:30 P.M. on Tuesday, June 30, 2015 at the Fourth & Bedford Church of Christ in Dimmitt with Mr. Carter Townsend officiating. Interment will be in the Castro Memorial Gardens. Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory of Bartlesville, Oklahoma was in charge of the arrangements.

Visitation was held from 12 Noon until 6 P.M. Sunday , June 29, 2015 at the Stumpff Funeral Home in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

Mrs. Britt was born in Plainview, Texas on March 25, 1916 to Herbert H. and Dora (Stallings) Houtchens.
