Mr. Floyd Lee Grundy, 94, of Bartlesville, died at 12:10 A.M. on Sunday, January 25, 2015 at the Heritage Villa Nursing Center.

Funeral services for Mr. Grundy will be held at 2 P.M. Saturday, January 31, 2015 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Tom Cox officiating.

Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery where full military rites will be accorded by the Ceremonial Detail of the James H. Teel American Legion Post # 105. Funeral services and interment are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Grundy was born on August 24, 1920 at Mena, Arkansas. He was the son of William A. Grundy and Mary Ellen (McCain) Grundy. They moved to Ramona, OK when he was young and he received his education from Ramona schools. He served his country in the United States Army in World War II. He received his Honorable Discharge in 1945. Floyd was employed with Phillips Petroleum Company for 40 years. He and Virginia Lee Brashear were married on December 29, 1945 in Bartlesville.

Floyd is survived by his wife, Virginia of the home, a daughter, Diana and husband Dr. David Doyle of Happy Valley, Oregon, one daughter-in-law, Debbie Grundy of Miami, Okla., four grandchildren and six great grandchildren.

Floyd is preceded in death by his parents, two sons, Floyd Wayne Grundy and Duane Lee Grundy, two sisters and one brother.
