Floyd Michael Overton, 80, of Bartlesville, passed away on March 14, 2026. Born in Enid OK on January 21, 1946, to Floyd and Dorothy Overton. He was a resident of Bartlesville for 50 years.

A graduate of Northwestern College Alva, OK, Floyd worked for Phillips Petroleum and served in the 101st Airborne of The United States Army during the Vietnam War. He married Linda Ewbank, on April 7, 1966. Together, they shared 60 years of marriage, and he was a member of First Baptist Church.

Floyd found his greatest happiness in ranching and raising show livestock. One of his most cherished and final memories was spending time in the pasture feeding the calves with his great-grandson, Reid—a moment the family will forever hold dear.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his sister-in-law, Teresa Overton.

Floyd is survived by his wife, Linda; his son, Timothy (Tracey) Overton of Skiatook, OK; grandchildren, Jordan Overton of Chatham, NJ, and Jacelyn (James) Hockaday of McKinney, TX; great-grandson, Reid Hockaday; and his brothers, Mark (Jeannie) Overton of Covington, OK and Don Overton of Wichita, KS.

Floyd's final words to his wife were a peaceful reflection of his journey: "I had a good life."
