Frances Jolene Garrett, 80, of Vinita, Oklahoma, died at her home in Craig County on December 10, 2017. She was born January 25, 1937, in Prairie Grove, Arkansas, the daughter of Leonard Richard McCallie and Flora Jane Crook McCallie. She was a retired contracts analyst, working for the United States Department of Energy in Tulsa, and the United States Air Force at the Pentagon in Arlington, Virginia. Before entering the civil service, she worked for Phillips Petroleum Company in Bartlesville and for Washington County, and she was also a schoolteacher, bookkeeper and homemaker. She was a graduate of Westville High School in Westville, Central Christian College in Bartlesville, and the University of Arkansas in Fayetteville. She was a member of the Vinita church of Christ and served as secretary for the church after she retired. On August 24, 1957 she married Justin Lanier Garrett in Westville. They remained married until his death earlier this year.
