Frances Cleo Remington, 95, passed away on April 30, 2020.

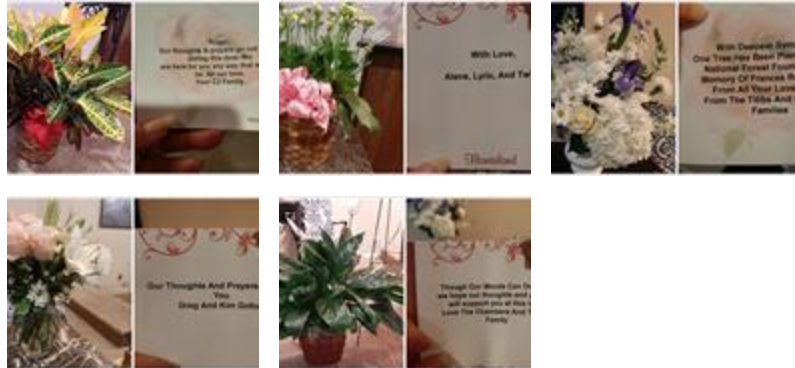
