Frank W Crow, age 95 of Bartlesville, OK passed away Wednesday evening, October 14, 2015.

Frank was born October 27, 1919 in Trinidad, Co. to Greenwood Wilford and Maude L. Crow. He grew up in Chicago, IL then Branson, MO. After graduating from school he was employed by Montgomery Ward Company in Cushing, OK then Bartlesville, OK. He met the love of his life in Bartlesville, Dorothy Doud Crow, and they were married in 1941. They made their home in Bartlesville, raised two children and were married over 70 years.

He served in the Army Air Force from 1941 – 1945, achieving the rank of Master Sergeant After an honorable discharge from the Army he accepted a position in Bartlesville as an Electrical Engineer with the Bureau of Mines. He worked for the Bureau of Mines for over 40 years retiring in 1985. Frank was a member of Toastmasters, the Institute for the Certification of Engineering Technicians (ICET), American Society of Certified Engineering Technicians (ASCET) and served on the Board of Trustees of the National Society of Professional Engineers.

Frank is survived by son, Frank R and Sheri Crow and daughter Barbara and Gary Winters, both of Bartlesville. Grandchildren, Jeremiah Crow, Rabekah Crow, and Sierra Crow, Great Grand Children Kandon, Meliah and Zeke Benjamin.
