August 3, 1924 - April 16, 2024

Georgalee Sawyer was born at Chelsea, OK, to Oliver Harvey and Edna (Dicks) Hobbs on August 3, 1924. She departed this life on April 16, 2024, just 4 months short of her 100th birthday.

After completing high school and business college, she did her bit for the WWII effort by working for the DuPont Company, operator of the Oklahoma Ordnance Works. On June 4, 1960, she and John G. Sawyer were married at the East Cross Methodist Church by the Rev Gene Miller. They made their home in Bartlesville, both being employed by Phillips Petroleum Company. In 1972, they were transferred by Phillips to the U.K. to work on the construction of the Teesside project. They returned to Bartlesville in 1979 where she continued her employment until her retirement in 1985.

After retirement, she enjoyed traveling, doing volunteer work, and gardening. She was a member of the Jane Phillips Society, Salvation Army Auxiliary, Hopeful Redbud Garden Club, and First United Methodist Church where she was active in the United Methodist Women, Grace Circle, and Twentieth Century Sunday School Class.

She was preceded in death by her husband John, parents and one sister Elaine Spray, niece Sue Inman, Nephew Jack Inman, and his wife Betty. She is survived by great-niece Julie (Dean) Hollenbeck of Nowata, OK and her
