Georgia Pearl Call, 102 years old, a longtime resident of Bartlesville passed on November 2, 2022.

She was born April 17, 1920 at Prague, Ok.

After graduating from Prague High School, Georgia went to work at Oklahoma City's Hubbard Hospital. She came to Bartlesville in 1946 where she met the love of her life, Eugene Call, and the two were married on Sept 29, 1947.

Gene and Georgia had 61 happy years together. The two loved spoiling their many nieces and nephews, all of whom are still closely connected.

They also enjoyed many adventures together like traveling to Oregon to see family and wintering in Texas.

Georgia favorite holiday was Christmas because "it's Jesus' birthday" and she really likes birthdays.

She was a true lover of life and people, and those privileged to be loved by her say they were inspired by her positive attitude towards life. Her words of wisdom to others "Take care of yourselves and live for the Lord"

She was preceded in death by her husband Gene, and her parents Joseph and Mrytle Fennell. There are only 2 of the 11 siblings still living, Hallie and Mary Francis.

Georgia was a member of the local First Baptist Church since 1957. In lieu of flowers a Memorial has been set up in her name to be given to the First Baptist Church of Bartlesville to go to the Internation Missions.

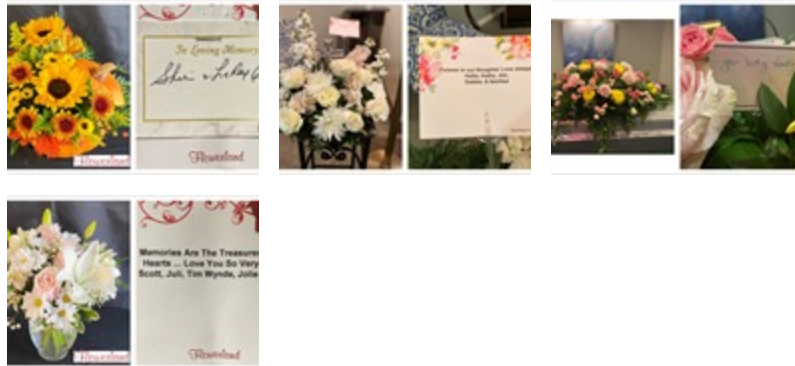
