Jerry Arnold died Sunday, July 1, 2012 at 10:30 P.M. in Bartlesville. Cremation arrangements were under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Jerry was born June 22, 1916 at Vian, OK to Augustus G. Arnold and Dora Belle Atkins Arnold. She moved with her family to Bartlesville, OK in August, 1923.

She graduated from Bartlesville High School in the class of 1936. She joined forces with Phillips Petroleum Company in December, 1936. Her dedication to her duties and a desire to excel in every job opportunity that she received led her to become the executive secretary for Ed Vandembark, vice-president of the International Department.
