Gloria May Kempf Kuhnert was received by God on July 10, 2023, following a short illness. A graveside celebration in her honor will be held Thursday, July 13, 2023, at Memorial Park Cemetery. Gloria was born on May 2, 1932, to Ella and George Hausinger in Beaver Dam, Wisconsin. After a divorce in 1932, her mother married Harmon Warner who legally adopted her. Gloria enjoyed acrobatics and tap dancing, along with a love for dogs and horses. She was a member of the marching band in junior high and high school and played the alto saxophone. After high school, she enrolled in the Milwaukee School of Massage where she met Thomas Charles Kempf. They were married on July 21, 1951. Together they were blessed with four children, Thomas Robert, Gary Allen, Randall Charles, and Lorrie Ann. They were married for 43 years.

Gloria started her own massage business which afforded her the opportunity to be home for her children after school. She enjoyed all sports, especially her Green Bay Packers. She was actively involved in her children's activities, most specifically swimming, gymnastics and track and field.

Gloria traveled to Germany, Alaska, and the Caribbean before marrying Vernon Kuhnert in 2005. Together they owned and operated V & G Market Place in Dewey, Oklahoma.

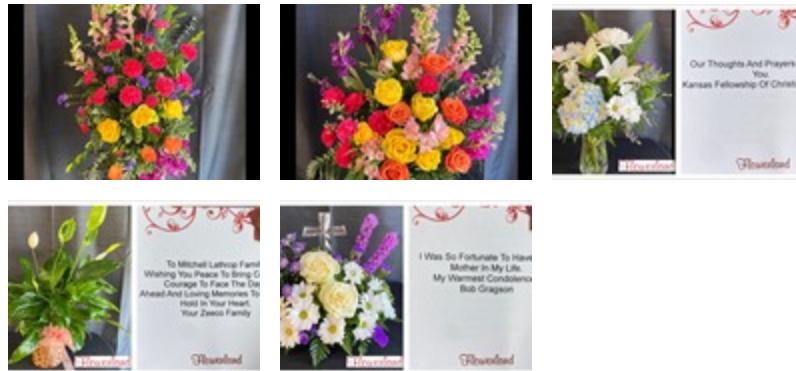
