Mr. Gregory “Greg” Allen Mueggenborg (“Mugg” to friends), 35, of Bartlesville, died at 7:17 P.M. on Wednesday, June 24, 2015 at the Jane Phillips Medical Center.

The memorial service will be held at 2 P.M. on Monday, June 29, 2015 at the St. Luke’s Episcopal Church with Father T. Lee Stephens officiating. The memorial register book will also be available for signatures at the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Mueggenborg was born in Bartlesville, Oklahoma on October 28, 1979 to Dennis Ray and Deborah Elaine (Kauffman) Mueggenborg. He spent Kindergarten thru 12th grade in the Bartlesville Public School System, attending Hoover Elementary, Madison Middle School, Bartlesville Mid High, then graduating from Bartlesville High School in 1998. He was active in sports with the Bartlesville Bruins wrestling, baseball, and football teams, as well as

with the American Legion Braves baseball. He attended the University of Oklahoma, from which he earned a Bachelor of Business Administration in Management Information Systems in 2002, and was an active member of the Beta Kappa chapter of Sigma Chi Fraternity. He then attended the University of Tulsa School of Law and earned his Juris Doctor in 2007. Mr. Mueggenborg was an attorney for Perrine, McGivern, Redemann, Reid, Berry & Taylor from 2008 to 2010. He was a member of the Oklahoma Bar Association and the OU Alumni Association, and remained an active and enthusiastic member of the Sigma Chi Fraternity. He was married to Shannon Muntz in Norman, Oklahoma on May 25, 2003, and they were blessed with their twins, John Allen and Samantha Jean, born on May 20, 2009. He had a special love for Bartlesville's Kiddie Park and enjoyed taking John and Samantha there every summer. He was an OU Football season ticket holder and had a special elevator pass so he could attend games even after his surgeries.

Mr. Mueggenborg was a life-long member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church, and served as an acolyte for much of his youth. He enjoyed a close friendship with Father T. Lee Stephens, including weekly visits of coffee and communion, and was thankful for this friendship to the very end.

Mr. Mueggenborg is survived by his twins, John Allen Mueggenborg and Samantha Jean Mueggenborg of Hendersonville, Tennessee; his parents, Dennis and Debbie Mueggenborg of Bartlesville; one brother, Jeff Mueggenborg and wife Tess of Dallas, Texas; his maternal grandmother, Peggy Kauffman of Okarche, Oklahoma; two brothers-in-law, Wes Muntz and wife Georgine of Grapevine, Texas and Wade Muntz and wife Tisha of Frisco, Texas; a host of aunts, uncles, cousins, Sigma Chi brothers, and a very special caregiver of the past five years, Kenny Rader. He was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, William and Helen Mueggenborg; his maternal great-grandparents, Pete and Pauline Ahlefeld; and his paternal great-grandparents, Anton and Margaret Mueggenborg and Joe and Clara Naberhaus.
