Mr. Harley Edsel Webb, 91, of Bartlesville, died Wednesday morning, February 24, 2016 at his home in Bartlesville.

Funeral services for Mr. Webb will be held at 10 A.M. on Saturday, February 27, 2016 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel with Pastor Joe Colaw of the First Wesleyan Church officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery where full military rites will be accorded by the James H. Teel American Legion Post # 105. Services and interment are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Webb was born at Shawnee, Oklahoma on April 9, 1924 the son of Riley Kester Webb and Mattie Jane (Rogers) Webb. He grew up and received his education at Tecumseh, Oklahoma until moving to California as a young man to become involved in the trucking industry. He entered the U.S. Army Air Corp and served in Burma during World War II until receiving his Honorable Discharge. He returned to California where he worked in the meat packing industry for a brief time until again becoming involved in the trucking industry. Mr. Webb was married to Christina Felix on May 12, 1947 in Las Vegas, Nevada. He was a truck driver until his retirement in 1962. They continued their home in California until moving to Bartlesville to make their home in 2002. Mr. Webb liked to fish and camp and working around his house. He had

attended the First Wesleyan Church in Bartlesville and the Calvary Chapel in Owasso.

Mr. Webb is survived by his wife, Mrs. Christina Webb of Bartlesville, one son, Gary Edsel Webb of Owasso, one daughter, Yvonne Edmundson and her husband, Thomas F. Edmundson of Bartlesville, three grandchildren, Suzanna Babbitt, Kevin Edmundson and Thomas F. Edmundson Jr., seven great grandchildren, Anisa Dawn Edmundson, Talisa Ann Edmundson, Brittney Edmundson, Courtney Babbitt, Baylee Babbitt, Anna Yvonne Edmundson and Bella Elizabeth Edmundson, and one great great grandson, Peyton Mundy. He was preceded in death by his parents and eleven brothers and sister.
