Harold Raymond Harris, 94, former resident of Bartlesville, died Friday April 12, 2013 in Midland, Texas.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 AM on Thursday, April 18, 2013 in the Adams Boulevard Church of Christ with Mr. Art Henley and Mr. David Hammonds officiating.
