Memorial services for Harriett L. Lansford will be observed at 2 p.m. on Saturday, September 11, 2021, at First Christian Church in Bartlesville, OK. At the time of her passing at The Journey Home, on August 31, 2021, she was surrounded by her children and the enduring love they had for her.

Mrs. Lansford impacted so many lives in Bartlesville. She was a pillar of strength to her family and all those who knew her. She faced many tests in her life and responded to all of them with courage and resoluteness. Harriett lived every day with her feet planted firmly on the rock of her unwavering faith in

Oris and Harriett were fixtures at the American Legion ballpark for many seasons, attending so many games they didn't even bother to take their lawn chairs home, rather just folding them and leaning them against the wall of their favorite box until the next game. They were once honored by the team between innings at a game for their long-term loyalty to the program.
