



Hartmut Holtz

May 11, 1941 - June 24, 2023

Hartmut Holtz passed away on June 24, 2023, at the age of 82. He was born to Johann Detlev Holtz and Marie-Louise Seeler on May 11, 1941, in Dormagen, Germany.

Hartmut came to the United States in March of 1953 on the Gripsholm ship from Germany. After graduating from College High School in Bartlesville in 1959, Hart enlisted in the Navy where he served in the Seabees for four years and gained his United States Citizenship. Afterwards he worked as a union electrician before becoming a successful electrical contractor. He established Holtz Electric in December of 1977 with his business partner Don Collins. On June 23, 1978, Hartmut married Theresa Jane Todd. He enjoyed his horse herd, collecting coins, watching sports, and reading the newspaper. He was a dedicated member of the National Electrical Contractors Association and enjoyed sharing his knowledge of the electrical industry. He loved being a father, grandfather, and husband.

Hartmut was preceded in death by his father, Johann Holtz; mother, Marie-Louise Woodruff; and brother, Hans-Dietrich Holtz.

Hartmut is survived by his wife, Theresa Holtz; sons, Todd Holtz and wife Betsie, Boomer Holtz and wife Beverly, and Art Holtz; sister, Irmgard Cate and husband Don; grandchildren, James Holtz, Ian Holtz, Chris Moore, Cody Moore, and Lorna and Bridget Darling; nieces Anita, Susan, and Heidi, and nephew Steven.

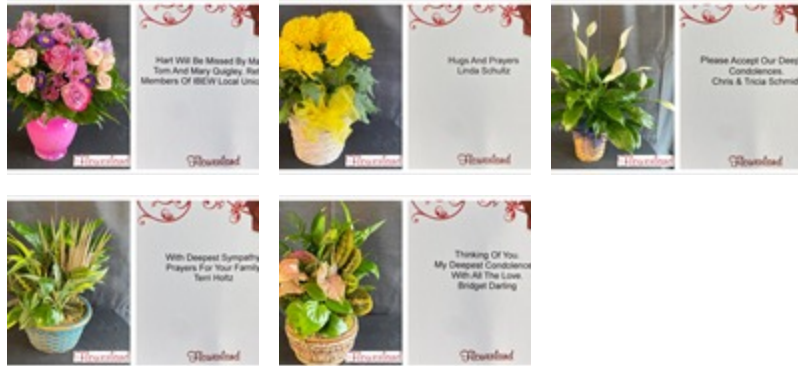
