Mr. Howard W. Alexander, 73, of Bartlesville, died at 3:42 A.M. on Sunday, July 28, 2013 in Wichita, Kansas.

Mr. Alexander attended Texas A & M University (a military school) until he joined the U.S Air Force in 1960 and was honorably discharged in 1964 from Minot, North Dakota. He was married to Marian Emily Niccum on September 23, 1961 at Minot. Mr. Alexander worked in various cities around the U. S. as his employment transferred him to various places. He moved to Oklahoma in 1990 and was employed with Service Master Environmental Services until retiring in 2001. Mr. Alexander was a member of the Town & Country Christian Church, a Life Member of the National Rifle Association and a member of the American Legion.
