She then went to work at a Nevada Casino show room as a waitress and there she later met the love of her life Willard "Bill" L. Oliver, they married on January 26, 1961. They raised their daughter Lisa in the Nevada-Idaho area. Bill preceded Ila in death in June of 1985 after 21 years of marriage. Ila later married Clifford Zufelt in Twin Falls, Idaho; he preceded her in death in 2006. At that time Ila moved to Skiatook where she lived with her daughter Lisa, son in law Alvin Foshee and her grandchildren. Her family was her pride and joy. She loved

cooking and working in the yard and spending time with her grandchildren and great grandchildren. Ila will be greatly missed by all that knew and loved her, Mom always told us "Time helps heal the pain". She will be in our hearts forever.
