Mrs. Mary "Irene" Towers, 90, of Bartlesville, died at 3:10 P.M. on Monday, May 29, 2017 at her home.

A Reflection of Life Service will be held at 7 P.M. on Thursday at the Bethel AME Church, 618 S.W. Adams Blvd.

Celebration of Life service will be held at 11 A.M. on Friday at the Spirit Church, 900 South Dewey, Bartlesville with Pastor Darryl Wootton officiating and Rev. W.T. Brown as the eulogist. Interment will be in the Sanders Cemetery in Craig County directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Visitation will be held at the Stumpff Funeral Home until 8 P.M. on Thursday.

Mrs. Towers was born on May 25, 1927 at the Choctaw Coal Mine Co. in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Clarence and Louise (Ward) Walton. She grew up in Arkansas where she moved to Oklahoma with her family and later to Craig County, Oklahoma at the age of 18. She was married in Bartlesville to Eugene (Gene) Towers and they made their home in the Big Creek area of Craig County until moving to Bartlesville in 1955. They have made their home in Bartlesville since that time and Mrs. Towers was active as a homemaker. Her doors were always open to anyone and she and Mr. Towers raised his siblings as well as numerous other children including Jade House. She was a faithful member of the Bethel A.M.E. Church where she sang in the choir, was a member of the Stewards's Board and Trustee Boards and was known as the "Mother of the Church". She was also a member of the Order of Eastern Star

and Good News cookoff.
