Jacqueline Dunlap Stanley, 92, died Tuesday, August 28, 2012 at her home surrounded by her family.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 AM on Friday, August 31, 2012 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel. Interment will be in the Ochelata Cemetery under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory. Military rites will be conducted by the James H. Teel American Legion Post # 105 of Bartlesville.

Jacqueline Dunlap Stanley was born September 25, 1919 at Sapulpa, Oklahoma to Freel and Vesta (Lawley) Dunlap. She was raised and received her education in Sapulpa and graduated Central High School in Tulsa, Oklahoma in 1937. Mrs. Stanley was employed with Southwestern Bell Telephone for two years before joining the U.S. Army. She served from September 1, 1943 to September 25, 1945. Mrs. Stanley served in North Africa and Italy as a telephone operator, serving with General Dwight Eisenhower and General George Patton. She received the Good Conduct Metal, Meritorious Unit Award, the European African Middle Eastern Theater Ribbon, one Bronze Battle Star and three Overseas Service Ribbons. Mrs. Stanley was married to Carl D. Stanley on February 6, 1954 at Colorado

Springs, Colorado. They made their home in Denver Colorado from 1954 to 1983. In 1983 they moved to the Ochelata, Oklahoma area before moving to Bartlesville in 1999. Mrs. Stanley was a member of the Ochelata Baptist church and served as a volunteer at the Jane Phillips medical Center for over fifteen years. She was a member of the Veteran's of Foreign Wars and the James H. Teel American Legion Post #105 of Bartlesville.

Survivors include her husband Carl D. Stanley of the family home in Bartlesville; two daughters Kay Jenean Shipman and her husband Mike of Bartlesville, and Charlene Norris and her husband Tom also of Bartlesville; seven grandchildren Jacque Lynn Dickson, Shelly Thompson, Roksanne Laxson, Rock Minghetti, Tina Laxson, Don Laxson and his wife Amy and Kellie Norris; eight great-grandchildren Benjamin Laxson, Jade Minghetti, Ethan, Austin and Ayden Thompson, Chase and Cody Laxson and Penelope Norris; niece Joan Hartman; great nieces Vicki Guetteriez and Dusty Williams. Mrs. Stanley was preceded in death by her parents, one daughter Sue Rae Carter and one sister Betty Hartman.
