Mrs. Jane Reese Baldwin Dillon, 86, of Claremore and formerly of Bartlesville, died at 7:35 P.M. on Friday, March 21, 2014 at the Wood Manor Nursing Home in Claremore.

Funeral services for Mrs. Dillon will be held at 2 P.M. on Tuesday, March 25, 2014 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Robert Ramsey officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mrs. Dillon was born on February 3, 1928 at Schulter, Oklahoma to William Henry and Velma (Moody) Reese. She grew up and received her education in Bartlesville and graduated from high school here. She was married to James L. Baldwin on April 21, 1944 in Bartlesville. They made their home in Bartlesville for the majority of their married life with the exception of a brief period in Texas during Mr. Baldwin's military service and later in Claremore. Mr. Baldwin preceded her in death on July 26, 1992. She was active for many years as owner of a day care in Bartlesville and she had also been involved in property management and later as a care giver for DHS. She was married to Donald Dillon on March 15, 1996 in Bartlesville and they made their home in Bartlesville. Mr. Dillon preceded her in death on February 13, 2002 and she

moved to Claremore to make her home in 2011. She was a member of AARP, a former member of the First Church of the Nazarene in Bartlesville and the Harvestime Assembly of God in Dewey. She loved to garden, crochet and ceramics.

Mrs. Dillon is survived by four daughters, Wanda Sue Chaney and husband John of Claremore, Patricia Elaine Lee and husband Jack of Catoosa, Jannette Ramsey and husband Bruce of Tulsa and Nancy Majors and husband Jimmie Joe of Bartlesville, one son, James L. Baldwin Jr. and wife Martha of Tulsa, one sister, Velma Lee Richard and husband Alfred (Boe) of West Lake, Louisiana, 10 grandchildren and 12 great grandchildren.
