Mrs. Jane H. Creath, longtime Ramona resident, died at 4:47 P.M. on Saturday, October 25, 2014 at the Jane Phillips Medical Center.

Memorial services for Mrs. Creath will be held at 2 P.M. on Tuesday, October 28, 2014 at the First Baptist Church in Dewey with her son-in-law, Pastor Mark Wright, officiating. Cremation arrangements were under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Jane was born at Cleveland, Oklahoma on October 13, 1933, the daughter of Joseph Harold House and V. Loweda (Allen) House. She grew up and received her education in Cleveland where she graduated from Cleveland High School in 1951. She was married to Don L. Creath on February 9, 1957 at Arkansas City, Kansas. They made their home in various locations in Missouri and Kansas until moving to Ramona in 1973, and Mr. Creath was active as a football, basketball and baseball coach. Jane worked in doctor's offices in Missouri and Kansas, and after moving to Ramona, was employed in the Caney Valley School System where she eventually became the secretary to the superintendent. She then served as the City Clerk for the Town of Ramona from 1991 until her retirement in 2011. She was a member of the First Baptist Church in Dewey. She loved her grandchildren and was known as "Grandmother" to all who knew her. She loved attending her grandchildren's various functions. She taught her grandchildren to play chickenfoot dominos and yahtzee and always bought their Easter clothes and winter coats. She

also loved to watch NCIS on tv and was generous to a fault.

Jane is survived by two daughters, Cindy Wright and husband Mark of Dewey, and Beth Stukey and husband Ron of Cushing, one son, Russ Creath and wife Lycrecia of McKinney, Texas, one sister, Norma Smith of Oklahoma City, a brother-in-law, Fenton Morrison of Ponca City, 11 grandchildren, 16 great grandchildren and her dog, Buddy. She was preceded in death by her parents, one sister, Jo Ellen Morrison, an infant daughter, Lisa Ann Creath, and her husband, Don L. Creath on June 4, 2008.
