Janice “Jann” Faye Brewer Reddell, 71, passed away peacefully on June 23, 2021, in Houston, Texas surrounded by many family members. 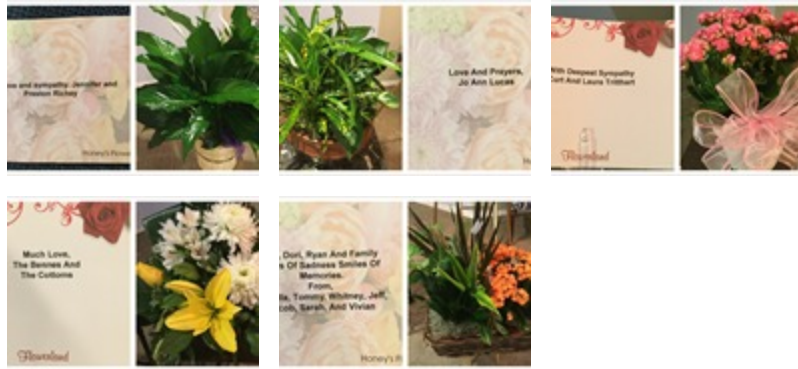
