



Janne Green Duell

October 3, 1935 - December 5, 2018

Janne Green Duell, 83, a long-time Bartlesville resident, passed away at The Journey Home Hospice in Bartlesville on December 5, 2018.

Janne, the only child of Thomas Lee Roy and Martha Reddick Green was born in Borger, Texas on October 3, 1935. Her father was employed by Phillips Petroleum Company and was transferred to Bartlesville in 1941 where Janne received her education and graduated from College High School with the Senior Class of 1953. She attended Oklahoma A & M and then married Jack Stoabs of Barnsdall. They lived in Tampa, Florida for one year and had a son, Bill. She was later married to Bobby Joe Noyes, a game ranger for Washington County and they also had a son, Tom. Janne later went to work for Phillips Petroleum Company where she was employed for 23 years. Janne and Fred B. Duell were married on November 19, 1966 in Nowata, a union which lasted until Mr. Duell's death on November 7, 2009. They traveled extensively during their marriage by touring motorcycles in the early years and then by more conventional means as they grew older. Janne worked for McCrory Architects, Ambler Architects and Tri County Technical School for several years after leaving Phillips, retiring in 2000. She was a member of the Bartlesville Art Association and served as treasurer for many years. She was a member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church. Janne spent the last 2 ½ years in assisted living at Green Country where she very much enjoyed the people and staff that helped her at her new home. Art, needlepoint and loving her animals were activities she enjoyed.

Janne is survived by two sons, Bill Stoabs and wife Becky of Anchorage, Alaska and Tom Noyes of Kansas City, Kansas. She was preceded in death by her husband Fred and her parents.
