Jason Allen (Schultz) Arnhols, 38, of Ochelata died Thursday July 26th unexpectedly at his home in Ochelata.

Jason was born December 17, 1973 at San Antonio Texas, the son of James Schultz of Des Moines, IA and Sherry Buckman of Des Moines, IA and Tulsa, OK. He was raised in Des Moines until he was 5, then moved to Tulsa with his mother where he received his education at Tulsa Public Schools and Union Schools.
