Jerry Dean Davis, 65, of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, passed away at his home on Saturday, April 26, 2025.

Born in Mooreland, Oklahoma, Jerry was the son of Marion and Irene (Ramey) Davis. He grew up in Sedan, Kansas, and graduated from Sedan High School in 1977. He had one sister, Judy Spellins (Davis), who preceded him in death.

On July 17, 1984, Jerry married Lisa Hartness of Peru, Kansas. Together they had three children: two daughters, Jessica and Jordan, and a son, Braden.

Jerry was a hardworking man who spent much of his life traveling the country as an equipment operator for various pipeline companies. He was a former member of Local Pipeline Union 798 and was affiliated with Operator Unions 178 in Fort Worth, TX, and 465 in Durham, NC. Throughout his career, he also worked in the oil fields and in fabrication shops. Jerry had a passion for working with his hands, often creating unique items and taking pride in every project. He found joy in riding and working on motorcycles, tackling projects around the house, and, most of all, caring for the love of his life, Debora.

Jerry and Debora (Cantwell) Davis were married on September 9, 2008. They made their home in Nowata, Oklahoma, before briefly returning to life on the

road together with the pipeline. They eventually settled in Bartlesville, where they continued to build a life together.

Jerry is preceded in death by his parents and sister. He is survived by his beloved wife, Debora, of the home; his daughters Jessica O'Brien and husband Thomas of Rattan, OK; Jordee Crawford and husband Jacob of Niotaze, KS; and his son Braden Davis and wife Lindsay of Peru, KS. He is also survived by his stepdaughters, Rhonda and Jessica. Jerry was a proud grandfather and great-grandfather to many, all of whom he loved deeply.

Cremation has taken place, and a celebration of life will be held at a later date.
