



## Jerry Ray Scamahorn

September 1, 1941 - November 19, 2015

Scamahorn, Jerry Ray, 74, retired crew clerk for BNSF Railroad, passed away November 19, 2015 in Bartlesville, OK.

Jerry was born September 10, 1941 in Nowata, OK to parents Leland and Dorothy (Montgomery) Scamahorn. In 1959 Jerry entered in the United States Navy. He was assigned to the Naval Air Station in Lemoore, CA and was deployed on the aircraft carrier's U.S.S. Coral Sea (CV-43) and U.S.S. Hancock (CV-19) in support of the Vietnam conflict. On September 7, 1962 Jerry received his Honorable Discharge and completed his proud service to his country. Jerry then moved back to Oklahoma to finish his education, graduating from Delaware High School. On October 9, 1965 Jerry married Twyla Kay Marler in rural Nowata county. For Jerry, family and faith were both very important. He was a deacon at Hillside Christian Church in Nowata, OK. Jerry is survived by his devoted and loving wife Twyla, of 50 years; his daughter Michelle Rutledge and her husband Rob of Weatherford, TX; son Floyd Scamahorn and his wife Ann of Bartlesville, OK; Grandchildren Laramie Rich, Hannah Scamahorn, and Abigail Scamahorn; sister Anne Peargen and husband David of Vallejo, CA; aunt Billie (Montgomery) Whitney and numerous cousins, nieces and nephews.
