Jerry Raymond Troxell, 84, passed away on May 26, 2022. He was born to Delbert Raymond Troxell and Mildred (Stowe) Troxell on May 27, 1937, in Bartlesville, Oklahoma. Jerry graduated in 1956 from College High School. He attended N.E.O for a short time before spending two years in the army.
