Jo Ellen "Jody" Reynolds Kirberger, age 84, died peacefully in her sleep June 4, 2014 in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, with her family by her side.

Jody was born in Tulsa on October 13, 1929, to Ruth and Charles Reynolds. She attended Tulsa Central High School and college at OSU. She married William Jordan Kirberger on June 4th, 1948. They were married for 66 years, to the day.

In 1957 the Kirberger's brought their four children to Bartlesville, where she spent the rest of her life. Her parents, Ruth and Charles Reynolds, moved to Taos, New Mexico in 1945 where he painted and she ran the Reynolds Art Gallery, and through her connection to Taos Jody met many artists. At her father's suggestion she opened the Talisman Gallery in 1963, which became a mecca for the arts in Oklahoma for over 45 years.

Her many contributions to the community included her work with OK Mozart, the ARC group home, and the Bartlesville Animal Shelter. She is remembered for her energetic dedication to many projects, and for her lifelong philanthropy to various causes.

She is preceded in death by her parents, her brother Charles, and her son William Kirberger, Jr. She is survived by her husband Bill, her sister Ruth Ann Treon, her daughters Karol, Jan and Laura and her grandsons Lyle Baker, William Wadsworth, Alex Wadsworth, Jesse Kirberger and Marlon Savinelli.
