MR. JOE "FRED" HOLLAND OBITUARY

Joe "Fred" Holland, 88, entered into eternal peace at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, June 20, 2014 in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, surrounded by his daughter and close friends.

Fred was born on June 4, 1926 in Westville, Oklahoma to Robert B. and Eula D. (Choate) Holland. He was raised and graduated from Westville High School. He was married to Reba "Oletha" Robinson Holland, his best friend and life-long dance partner, on June 13, 1953 at Nowata, Oklahoma. She preceded him death in 2000. Fred was devoted to his family. He loved animals, children, dancing, spending time with his friends and playing the fiddle. Fred served in the United States Army during the Korean War and was stationed in Germany. Fred retired from Phillips Petroleum Company as a Facilities Manager in 1983 after 38 years of service. Fred also owned his own company, Holland Homes Construction Company. Fred loved building houses and did so for over thirty years.
