Mr. John Michael Spurgeon, 59, of rural Barnsdall, died at 8:24 A.M. on Saturday at his home following an illness.

He grew up and received his education traveling to various locations with his father's work on seismograph crews. He went to Florida at the age of 18 and later to Mississippi and Louisiana. He was employed as a seismic technician first with United Geophysical and then with Phillips Petroleum for 28 years during which he lived in the Bartlesville area. He was later employed with Dawson Geophysical for 13 years in Midland, Texas and returned to Oklahoma in April of 2010.
