The extent of her heart defects were not fully known until she was born. After additional testing after her birth, they determined that her diagnosis was Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome (HLHS). We didn't know that she had inferior coronary arteries as well. There we started our journey to a heart transplant for our peanut. We always said if our sweet girl is fighting to be here, we are fighting with her. This amazing girl spent 4 months and 27 days in a hospital fighting so fiercely and was such a happy smiley baby despite everything and was so full of life. It was in waiting for this heart after a while, it became obvious Jo wasn't able to keep fighting. On December 27th at 5:13 pm, in the same hospital she was born in, our amazing girl passed peacefully in her mama's arms with daddy close by. This amazing little redhead had the most spunk and life in her. She was and is so loved for the spirit she brought with her earthside. The most amazing girl in this universe will be cremated and reside with her parents in Nowata, Oklahoma.

Claire, Grandpa Wes and Grandma Laurie.
