Juanita Thompson Gaut, 94, of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, died Jan 11, 2023, at 12:30 am.

Mrs. Gaut was born May 21, 1928, in Nowata, Oklahoma, to S.W. and Eva Thompson. She attended Nowata schools, graduating from high school in 1946. She went to work for Phillips Petroleum Company after graduation and worked for three years in the Purchasing department.
