



Judson Charles Rowland

October 29, 1942 - May 20, 2021

Mr. Judson Charles Rowland, 78, of Bartlesville, died at 9 A.M. on Thursday, May 20, 2021, at his home in Bartlesville.

Funeral services for Mr. Rowland will be held at 2 P.M. on Tuesday, May 25, 2021, at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. Private interment will be in the Wann Cemetery at Wann, Okla directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Rowland was born in Topeka, Kansas on October 29, 1942. He grew up and received his education at Topeka. He entered the United States Navy in October 1961. He was stationed in San Diego, California, and Japan for 8 years. He was then assigned to Concord Naval Station in California from which he had numerous deployments to VietNam on a munitions ship most requested by the aircraft carriers. He was then assigned to the Lockheed Trident Missile facility where he was the military liaison for 4 years. From there he served for one year (and credited 3 years of sea time) in Antarctica as military support for the National Science Fund "Operation Deep Freeze". He then went to Little Rock, Arkansas to the Military Entrance Examination Station until his retirement in 1983 after 23 years of service. Following his Honorable Discharge, he moved to Wann, Oklahoma to be near family and had been employed for the city water departments in Bartlesville, Copan, and Nowata. The family moved to Bartlesville earlier this year. He was married to Edwina Marie Burns on May 22, 1971, in Garden Grove, California. He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints and he was a

devoted father, grandfather, and great grandfather.

Survivors include his wife Marie Rowland of Bartlesville, one daughter Deanna Roszel and husband Loren of Bartlesville, two brothers, Bob Thomas and Jimmy Thomas both of Texas, two sisters, Jean Mertz and Connie DeCoito both of Nebraska, two grandchildren, Ashley Watt and Taylor Watt and two great-grandchildren, Lillei Cornelius and Kenzie Cornelius. He was preceded in death by his mother, Frankie Lucas, his father, Judson Fillmore Rowland, and a brother Johnnie Lucas.

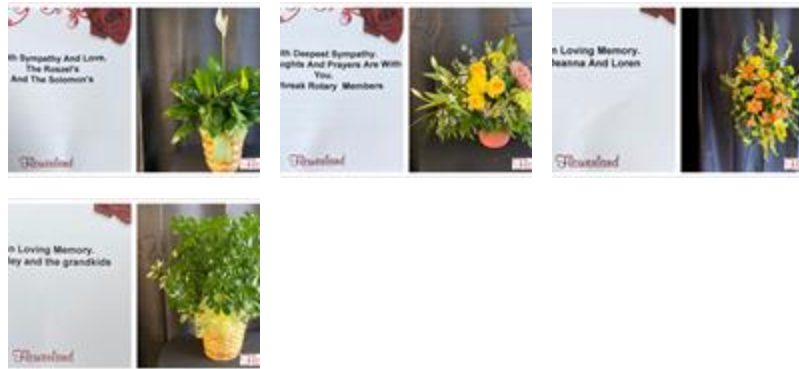
