Katrin Cynthia (Watt) Sumpter passed away in Tulsa, OK, on December 13, 2021, at the age of 73. Katrin was born May 13, 1948, to Jack Richard Watt and Gudrun Karlsdottir Watt in Reykjavik, Iceland.

Katrin graduated from Oklahoma State University with a BA in English. 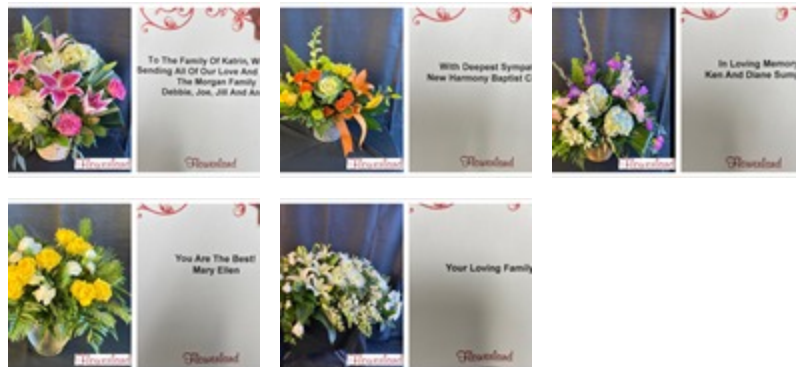
