Mr. Kenneth Wayne Charter, 75 of Barnsdall, died at 5:30 A.M. on Sunday, June 7, 2015 at the Barnsdall Nursing Home.

Funeral services for Mr. Charter will be held at 10 A.M. on Wednesday, June 10, 2015 at the Barnsdall Assembly of God Church with Pastor Jason Byers officiating. Funeral services are under the direction of the Stumpff Barnsdall Funeral Home.

They made their home in Barnsdall and he was employed with the garment factory in Pawhuska and then at the BARECO plant in Barnsdall for 13 years. He then became an Assembly of God minister serving churches at Bluejacket, Oklahoma for nine years, Soper, Oklahoma for four years, again at Bluejacket for six years and then at Crowder, Oklahoma for a year until his retirement in 2001. Mr. and Mrs. Charter returned to Barnsdall to make their retirement home and he was employed at the Oklahoma Lake Patrol office at Birch Lake. He was a member of the Barnsdall Assembly of God Church.

Mr. Charter is survived by his wife, Mildred Ruth Charter of Barnsdall, one son, Bruce Charter of Tulsa, one daughter, Kenna Foote and husband Richard of Fair Grove, Missouri, a grandson, Brett Speer and his partner Sierra Shrum, two great granddaughters, Natalee Speer and Raylee Russell, two brothers, Harold Charter of Longview, Texas and Garry Charter of Houston, Texas, two sisters, Pauline Slaybaugh of Moore, Okla. and Delores Alsup of Barnsdall and a number of nieces and nephews.
