Mr. Kenny Joe Rayner, 66 of rural Dewey, died Saturday, March 14, 2015 at his home.

Graveside services will be held at 2 P.M. on Thursday, March 19, 2015 at the Dewey Cemetery with Pastor Orville Moody of the Rose Hill Community Baptist Church officiating. Full military rites will be accorded by the Ceremonial Detail of the James H. Teel American Legion Post # 105. Services and interment are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral home & Crematory.

Mr. Rayner was born in Bartlesville on July 17, 1948 to Joseph Dryden Rayner and Velva (Hale) Rayner. He grew up and received his education in Dewey graduating from Dewey High School in 1966. He entered the U.S. Air Force on July 28, 1966 and served until March 22, 1970 and then continued as a member of the National Guard in Pawhuska. Following his active duty service he returned to the Dewey area and was employed with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company until his retirement as a cable splicing technician in 2000. He has continued his home at the family home place west of Dewey since that time. He raised mules and his dog, Wiley.

Survivors include his three siblings, David Rayner and wife Nancy of rural Dewey, Lisa Fox and husband Jerry of rural Dewey and John Rayner of Sapulpa and his nieces and nephews, Jeff Riley, Scott Riley, Amber Bell, Sara Rayner, Jayme Rayner, Emily Fox, Garrett Fox, J.D. Fox and Hayden Rayner. He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Karen Riley in 2003.
