Mrs. LaUna Genieva McClintock, 97, longtime Bartlesville area resident died Friday October 19th, in Rogers, Arkansas with her family by her side.

Graveside Services for Mrs. McClintock will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday October 23, 2012 at the White Rose Cemetery in Bartlesville, with Rev. Orville Moody of the Rosehill Community Church officiating. Funeral Services and interment were under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mrs. McClintock was born on November 11th, 1914 to Walter and Minnie Jones at Stigler, Oklahoma. At the age of 9 months she and her twin sister were moved to their maternal grandparent's home, due to the death of her mother. She was a resident of the Bartlesville area for over 90 years, until she recently moved to Rogers Arkansas to be near her daughter. She was a member of the Virginia Avenue Baptist Church for many years, and most recent was a charter member of the Rose Hill Community Baptist Church; and she loved her church and church family. In 1935 she met and married her husband Bert McClintock on December 15, 1935 at Bartlesville. They had

owned and operated the High Point Dairy northwest of Dewey, until 1950 when they moved into Bartlesville. They had celebrated their 50th Wedding anniversary in 1985. In retirement they enjoyed their family, spending time at the ranch, and activities at the 55 Plus Center. She was preceded in death by her husband Bert Mc Clintock in 1986.

Mrs. McClintock is survived by one daughter Mrs. Leona Long and her husband Perry of Lowell Arkansas, and by a son Bob McClintock and wife Delores of Bartlesville, her twin sister Mrs. Leona Turner and her husband Harold of Bartlesville; by five grandchildren, Tim McClintock, Brett and wife Hope McClintock, Todd and wife Angela McClintock, and Steve Nett and wife Mimi all of Bartlesville, and by Sherrie Wallace and husband Wayne of Dewey, 8 Great-grandchildren and 6 Great-great grandchildren.
