Lela Lula (Tinsley) Ellis, 104, died Sunday morning, January 26, 2014, at the Bartlesville Health & Rehab Center in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

Born August 27, 1909 in Scipio, Oklahoma, Lela was the first born of four children to Walter Phillip and Amanda Jane (Walker) Tinsley. The family later moved to El Reno, Oklahoma where Lela met and married William Clyde Ellis on March 17, 1928. They had two children, Edith Pauline (Ellis) Hough and Clyde Deane Ellis, who died in infancy. Through their 68 years of marriage, Lela and Clyde lived in El Reno, Hominy, Ramona and Bartlesville. Clyde preceded her in death on February 29, 1996.
