Leslie William Romine was reunited with his loved ones on September 27, 2013: his parents, Jess Marion Romine and Etta Zyra Wickham and the mother of his children, Dorothy Jean McIntosh.

Mr. Romine was born in Shaw, Kansas, and then was a lifelong Ochelatan. After graduation from Ochelata High School, Leslie served as a Corporal in the U.S. Army Air Corps in WWII from 1943 to 1946 and then again as Sergeant in the U.S. Air Force in the Korean Conflict from 1950 to 1951. Mr. Romine then became the rural mail carrier for Ochelata and covered a wide area for the country farms and ranchers. In his earlier years, Leslie was also active in the Ochelata Methodist Church. Mr. Romine lived a simple life and was a kind man who would literally give you “the shirt off his back”. He had a strong love and compassion for animals and mourned the passing of many a cherished pet throughout his life, especially his dogs.
