Lester D. Bogle, 76, former Dewey and Caney Kansas resident, died at 6:45 A.M. on Wednesday in Coffeyville, Kansas.

Funeral Services are scheduled for 4:00 P.M. On Saturday, August 12, 2017 at the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel, with Rev. Charles McKnight officiating. Cremation arrangements and services are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Bogle was born July 15, 1941 at Chanute, Kansas to Eugene LeRoy and Wynona Mae (Blough) Bogle. He grew up and attended school at Dewey, Oklahoma and at Havana, Kansas where he completed school and received his GED. He later received his Associates Degree from Independence Community College at Independence, Kansas. He was married to the former Laura Long on September 26, 1967 at Lake Havasu, California. They made their home at Santa Anna, California and in several other towns in southern California, until moving to Caney, Kansas in 1980. There they owned a snack shop for a few years, and he later drove a truck on a courier route. He had worked as a cashier in a convenience store, and worked for Cirtel in circuit board manufacturing for space shuttles, for missiles and submarine guidance systems for a naval base. His hobbies included playing cards, traveling, and visiting with people; which he really enjoyed.

Mr. Bogle is survived by his son Jared Bogle of Nowata, OK, and a daughter Karen Trester of Tulsa, OK. and by a sister, Peggy Barlow of McKittrick, California and two brothers; Leonard Bogle of Nashville Tennessee, and

Ronald Bogle of Springfield, Missouri, by two grandchildren; Casey McCammon of Kansas City, Kansas, and Kyler Bogle of Nowata, OK. He was preceded in death by his parents, by his wife; Laura Bogle in 1987, by four brothers Richard, Jerry, Bob and Paul Bogle, and by a sister; Shirley King.
