Mrs. Glenn was born at Stuttgart-Canstatt, Germany on April 19, 1931 the daughter of Vitus and Sofie (Hartenberger) Pfaffenzeller. She grew up in Stuttgart, Germany surviving World War II as a child. She was married to Joe Leon Glenn at Stuttgart on March 15, 1952. They made their home in Stuttgart while Mr. Glenn completed his service with the U.S. Army. Following Mr. Glenn's military discharge they made their home at Bowring , Oklahoma in 1952 and then moved to Bartlesville to make their home in March of 1953. Mr. Glenn was a detective with the Bartlesville Police Department from 1952 until his retirement as Captain of detectives in 1973. Mrs. Glenn was employed with Phillips Petroleum Company for over 30 years until her retirement in 1985. Mrs. Glenn loved to work needlepoint, gardening and taking care of her family.

Mrs. Glenn is survived by her husband, Joe Leon Glenn of Bartlesville, one son, Ron Glenn and wife Jani of Bartlesville, one daughter, Judy Glenn Kennell of Boerne, Texas, one brother, Vitus Pfaffenzeller of Germany, seven grandchildren, Joey Glenn, Mikey Glenn, Hunter Kennell, Allison Kennell, Elizabeth Kennell, Stephen Kennell and Kenneth Kennell and seven great grandchildren.
