Most of all she was an intelligent, sacrificially heart-giving, proud, **STRONG** woman. Linda was the most loving mother and wife anyone could ever hope for.

In February of 2017 David and Linda celebrated their 50th Wedding

Anniversary at the Little White Chapel in Las Vegas, Nevada in the same chapel and with the same officiant who married them in 1967.
