Mrs. Lola Traxson, 97, Bartlesville resident, died at 8:15 pm on July 20, 2015, at the Brookdale Assisted Living Home.

They moved to Bartlesville to be close to family in 1989. Mrs. Traxson was a member of the Adams Blvd. Church of Christ. Her husband, Johnnie, preceded her in death in 1990.

She is survived by 2 sons, Marvin and wife Donna, and Eldred. A daughter, Shirley Kimrey and husband Peewee. A daughter, Nancy Donley, deceased, and a son-in-law Curt Donley. She had four sisters and one brother, all deceased. She has many grandchildren, great children and great-great grandchildren. Lola was a soft spoken, unassuming lady. She lived her life quietly and did all that her Lord put into her life. Her life has been an inspiration to all who knew her and will remain so in our many memories we have of her life.
